The Clinical Faculty Leadership EXpress (C-FLEX) Program will help clinical faculty with at least 5 years' experience and a minimum of 50% effort at one of UCSF's four schools gain insights and skills to lead change and improve health care.

PROGRAM DETAILS

Grounded in Healthforce Center's leadership model and developed in partnership with the Academic Senate, this program provides relevant leadership training for clinical faculty in the health care settings in which they practice.

As a result, C-FLEX participants will:

- Increase self-awareness and self-efficacy in their leadership capabilities;
- Increase capacity for effective communication and engaging with conflict; and
- Expand professional networks

C-FLEX is designed to integrate with busy schedules. The program consists of three in-person training sessions held on the Parnassus campus:

- Thursday November 9, 2017, 1:30-4:00 p.m.
- Thursday November 30, 2017, 1:30-4:00 p.m.
