Proposed Revisions to SOD Regulations 5.3 Elective Courses Spring 2018

Proposed revisions include:

1. Deletion of SOD Regulation 5.3.2

Background:

Upon review of School of Dentistry Regulations 5.3 Elective Courses, it was recognized by SOD Administration that language in 5.3.2 was inaccurate and not being fulfilled, resulting in the school being out of compliance. They further recognized a discrepancy between the language and tone of 5.3.1 and 5.3.2. which this proposed revision aims to correct.

While 5.3.1. states that student's program "may" include electives, 5.3.2. states that students are "required" to enroll in specific number of elective courses. There is currently not a practice or process in place to support this and it is confusing to students.

As such, School Administration is requesting 5.3.2. be eliminated entirely.

At the School of Dentistry Faculty Council April 2018 meeting, members agreed and approved deletion of 5.3.2.

5.3 Elective Courses

5.3.1 Elective courses may be included in a student's program with the approval of the instructor and the Dean or the Dean's designated representative.

5.3.2 In the last three quarters of the dental curriculum, students are required to enroll in a specified number of courses, as determined by the Educational Policy committee of the School of Dentistry.

5.3 Elective Courses
